### **1. Cricket Season Debrief**

A general discussion was held on the outcomes and operational learnings from the recent cricket season. No major traffic or operational issues were experienced during the BBL or international cricket matches held at Ninja Stadium.

The committee noted the success of changes implemented prior to the season, particularly the traffic management company's operation of the Beach Street and South Street Reserve car parks, which contributed to improved traffic flow and parking management.

### **2. Schedule of Major Events**

The following major events were confirmed and shared with Clarence City Council and Tasmania Police:

1. 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026, 7:05 pm – VFL: Tasmania vs Carlton
2. 14<sup>th</sup> June 2026, 1:10 pm – AFL: Richmond vs Brisbane

### **3. Football Season Planning**

An overview of planning for the upcoming football season was discussed.

- Activation of the Traffic Management Plan (TMP) will occur three hours prior to event start times.
- The TMP will be circulated to all relevant stakeholders.

#### **Public Transport Arrangements:**

- For the VFL event, bus services will operate between Hobart and Bellerive, with services running every 15 minutes from 5:00 pm to the game.
- Return bus services from the game back to Hobart will operate every 15 minutes following the event.
- For the AFL event, ferry services will operate between Hobart and Bellerive.

#### **Parking:**

- South Street Reserve parking will be unavailable for the AFL match on 14 June. Clarence City Council is investigating and proposing alternative parking options.
- Clarence City Council will activate "No Parking" signage on major event days, commencing from the morning of each game.

### **4. Resident Communications**

Resident notifications will be published on the venue website 10 days prior to the first game. Notices will also be available at the reception desk at Ninja Stadium. Additional communication channels will be considered if required.
